Maths:

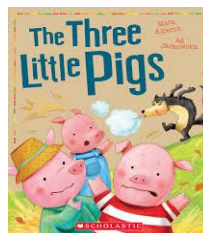
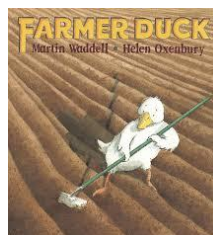
We will be looking closely at numbers 6 to 10. We will investigate how many ways we can make these numbers through partitioning each number to 10 in as many ways as possible. We will then learn our number bonds to 10 - 2 numbers that go together to make 10. We will then be ready to explore number problems involving addition and introduce the symbol + (plus).

English:

We will be reading 'Farmer Duck' by Martin Waddell and 'The Three Little Pigs'. Using these books, we will be learning how to respond to the pictures and write in simple sentences with growing independence. We will learn how to rehearse a simple sentence out aloud to support our developing writing skills. We will then sequence the pictures into the correct order to retell the story and use the key spelling words that are sent home to write a short retell. We will use our Read Write Inc knowledge for support and our sound mats located on our tables. We will continue to explore our new handwriting scheme, 'Kinetic Letters'.

Year One – Autumn 2

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Main focus: Geography

We will be studying the human and physical features of our local area of Cosham. We will take a walk into Cosham in late November (date to follow soon) and spot the physical and human features we see as we follow a specific route.

Key Vocabulary: near, far, route, direction, human, physical, map, key, school, field, pond, Cosham, shop, building

Science- We shall be learning about materials. We will learn the names of different materials and talk about their properties and why they suit certain objects.

Key Vocabulary: material, wood, plastic, glass, metal, wood, rock, hard, soft

Art

We will be studying the artist Karla Gerard and looking closely at patterns and texture. We will then create a home for the 3 little pigs to link with our theme.

Music

We will be singing familiar songs and practise the skills of performing them in time with our friends. We will also begin practising our songs for our Nativity Performance!

RE

The children will be exploring the concept of 'Light' and how light can be a symbol for several different religions.

Computing

We will be developing our understanding of technology and how it can help them in their everyday lives. We will create our own
