Maths:

In Maths, we will be expanding our knowledge of multiplication and division. We will also be looking at fractions, decimals and percentages, as well as area and perimeter.

English:

In English this half term, we will be looking at the novel 'Diver's Daughter'. Throughout the learning, we will focus on creating a diary from the perspective of one of the characters.

During Guided reading this term, we will be reading 'Diver's Daughter' to help deepen our understanding of the text. We will be analysing the book and using inference, prediction and retrieval skills to understand the characters and plot at a deeper level.

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Main focus:

History

We will be learning all about the Terrible Tudors: how they came to the throne, food and differences between rich and poor.

Vocabulary: banquet, monarchy, peasant, destitute, affluent, consequence and controversial.

Science

Our Science topic will be forces. Within our lessons, we will be exploring how forces such as gravity, friction, air resistance and water resistance occur through experiments. Science vocabulary: gravity, water resistance, air resistance, friction, surface area, force meter, newtons and streamlined.

Art

In art this term, we will be creating portraits of Tudor monarchs.

RE

Our big idea will be 'symbols' we will discuss symbols as a class as well as looking at the symbol of the Empty Cross and how that impacts Easter from Christians points of view.

Computing

This unit looks at how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records.

PE

We will also be improving our reaction and response in PE. PE will predominantly be on Wednesday and Thursdays.
